

FOOD HYGIENE RATING

Food Hygiene Rating Scheme: Request for a re-visit



Notes for businesses:

- As the food business operator of the establishment, you have a right to request a revisit for the purposes of re-rating if you have taken action to rectify the non-compliance identified at the time of inspection. This is provided when you have paid the reasonable costs (currently £203 as of 01/04/2024). Payment must be provided in advance at www.derby.gov.uk/food-pay
- You may apply for a re-scoring visit at any time and as often as you choose, as long as a payment of £203 is submitted with each request.
- You must provide details of the improvements made with your request, including supporting evidence where appropriate.
- If the local authority considers that you have provided sufficient evidence that the required improvements have been made, an
 unannounced inspection will be undertaken in accordance with our re-score visit procedure and within 12 weeks of your
 request.
- The local authority officer will give you a 'new' food hygiene rating based on the level of compliance that is found at the time of the re-visit you should be aware that your rating could go up, down or remain the same.
