

DERBY CITY COUNCILTOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING GENERAL DEVELOPMENT ORDER 1988Direction under Article 4(HARTINGTON STREET CONSERVATION AREA DERBY)

WHEREAS the Derby City Council ("the Council") being the appropriate local planning authority within the meaning of Article 4 of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1988 ("the Order") are of the opinion that development of the description set out in the first schedule hereto should not be carried out on land shown coloured green on the plan annexed hereto and detailed in the second schedule unless permission therefor is granted on application made under the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1988

AND WHEREAS the Council is further of the opinion that development of the said description would constitute a threat to the amenities of its area and that the provisions of paragraph 4 of the article 5 of the Order should apply to this direction _____

NOW THEREFORE the Council in pursuance of the powers conferred on it by the said Article 4 HEREBY DIRECT that the permission granted by article 3 of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1988 shall not apply to development on the said land of the description set out in the First Schedule hereto _____

THIS DIRECTION is made in pursuance of the provisions of paragraph 4 of article 5 of the Order and shall remain in force until 8 December 1990 (being six months from the date of this direction) and will then expire unless it has been approved by the Secretary of State for the Environment before that date _____

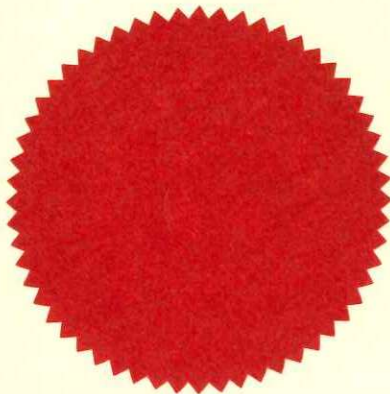
FIRST SCHEDULE

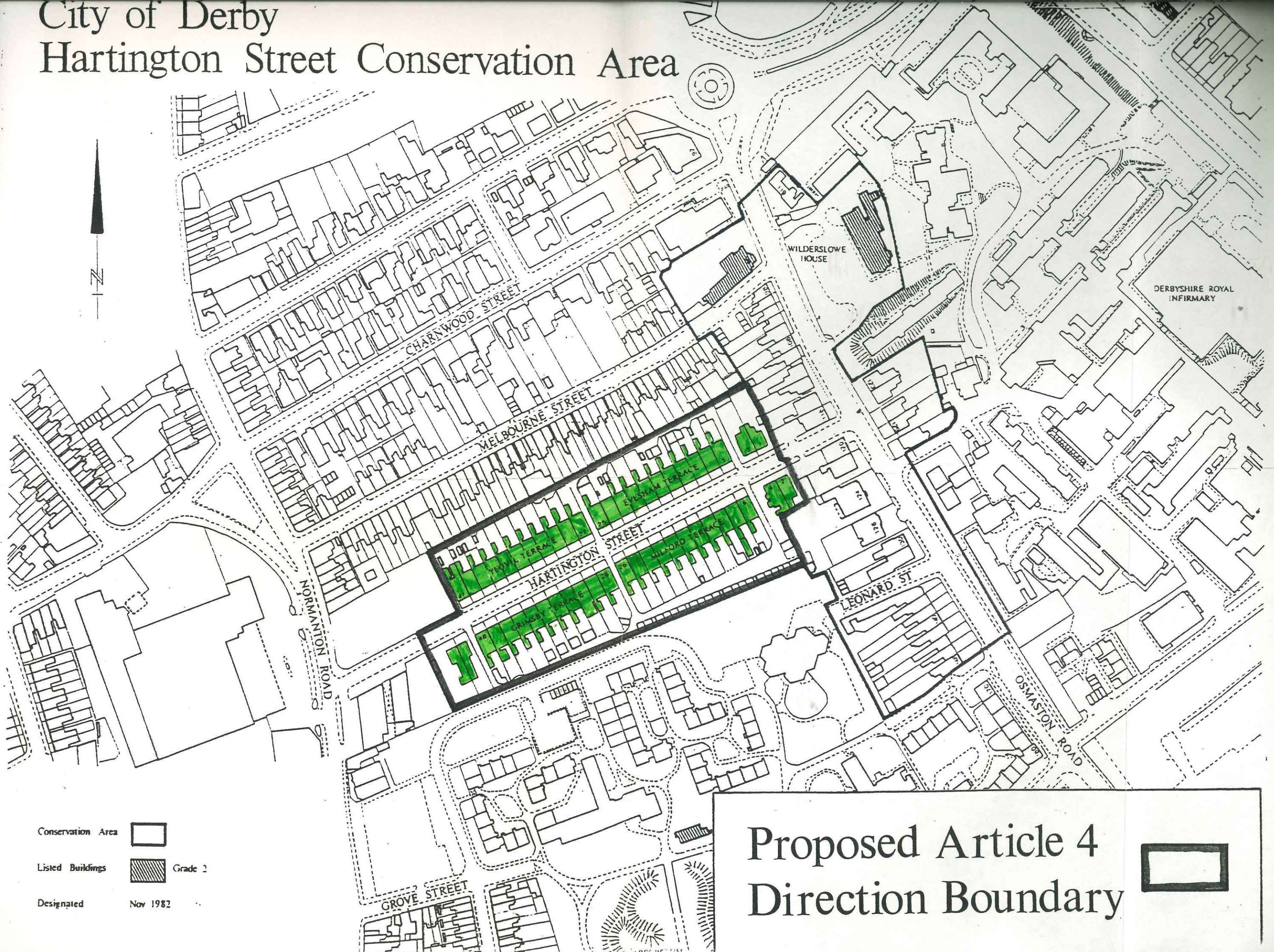
