Direction under Article 4

LITTLE CHESTER CONSERVATION AREA DERBY

WHEREAS the Derby City Council ("the Council") being the appropriate local planning authority within the meaning of Article 4 of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1988 ("the Order") are of the opinion that development of the description set out in the first schedule should not be carried out within the conservation area at those properties ("the Properties") within the area shown edged red on the plan annexed hereto and detailed in the second schedule unless permission therefor is granted on an application made under the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1988 AND WHEREAS the Council is further of the opinion that development of this description would constitute a threat to the amenities of its area and that the provisions of paragraph 4 of the article 5 of the Order should apply to this direction

NOW THEREFORE the Council in pursuance of the powers conferred on it by the said Article 4 HEREBY DIRECT that the permission granted by article 3 of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1988 shall not apply to development of the Properties of the description set out in the First Schedule hereto

of article 5 of the Order and shall remain in force until 29 April 1993 (being six months from the date of this direction) and will then expire unless it has been approved by the Secretary of State for the Environment before that date
