Explanation of level of support:

- **Universal:** services available to all children, young people and their families.
- **Targeted:** services for children and young people who may need additional support and may require an assessment of need to access services.
- **Specialist:** services for children and young people with severe and/or complex needs and will require an assessment of need to access services.
- **Tertiary:** NHS services commissioned regionally.

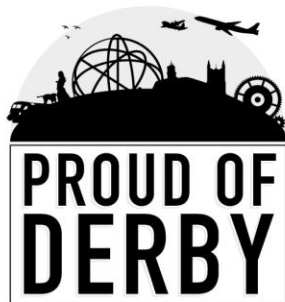
