The photo will be considered by an Enforcement Officer and confirmation will be sent as to whether the application/positioning is acceptable. Once approved, it will be the responsibility of the driver/proprietor to ensure that the items remain in excellent condition and replace at their own cost if it gets damaged or t the request of an Enforcement Officer. The positioning of any replacement will need to be verified by an Enforcement Officer.  'Internal signs – fare card/contact'  As these are branded items, for security, consistency, safety and accuracy, it is not proposed these are sourced from anywhere other than the Council.
