

The directions below will bring you along the most appropriate routes to any of the four main entry points. **Approaching Derby from the:**

West on A52

Stay on A52, follow signs for city centre east. At the junction with the Inner Ring Road, for city centre north turn left on to St Alkmunds Way, then Cock Pitt or for city centre south turn right on to Stafford Street, then Mercian Way.

East on A52

Stay on A52 to Pentagon roundabout stay on the left lane for city centre south to Cock Pitt junction or middle lane for city centre north to St Alkmunds Way.

North on A6

Turn left onto A38 North, then turn right on Derby A61 to A52 city centre Pentagon roundabout and turn right for city centre south to Cock Pitt junction or for city centre north to St Alkmunds Way.

South on A6

Follow signs for A52 city centre on to A5111 Raynesway, then turn left on to A52 city centre to Pentagon roundabout stay on the left lane for city centre south to Cock Pitt junction or middle lane for city centre north to St Alkmunds Way.

North on A38 either..

Turn left on to Derby A61 to A52 city centre Pentagon roundabout and turn right for city centre south to Cock Pitt junction or for city centre north to St Alkmunds Way.

Or..

Continue to A5111 Kingsway, then left on to A516 Uttoxeter New Road, at the next roundabout, turn left on to Stafford Street to St Alkmunds Way then Cock Pitt junction for city centre north or turn right on to Mercian Way for city centre south.

South on A38 either..

Turn left on to Derby A516 at roundabout take second exit on to Uttoxeter New Road, at next roundabout, turn left on to Stafford

Street to St Alkmunds Way then Cock Pitt junction for city centre north or turn right on to Mercian Way for city centre south.

Or..

Continue to A52 Ashbourne Road roundabout, take third exit and follow signs for city centre east. At the junction with the Inner Ring Road, for city centre north turn left on to St Alkmunds Way, then Cock Pitt or for city centre south turn right on to Stafford Street, then Mercian Way.

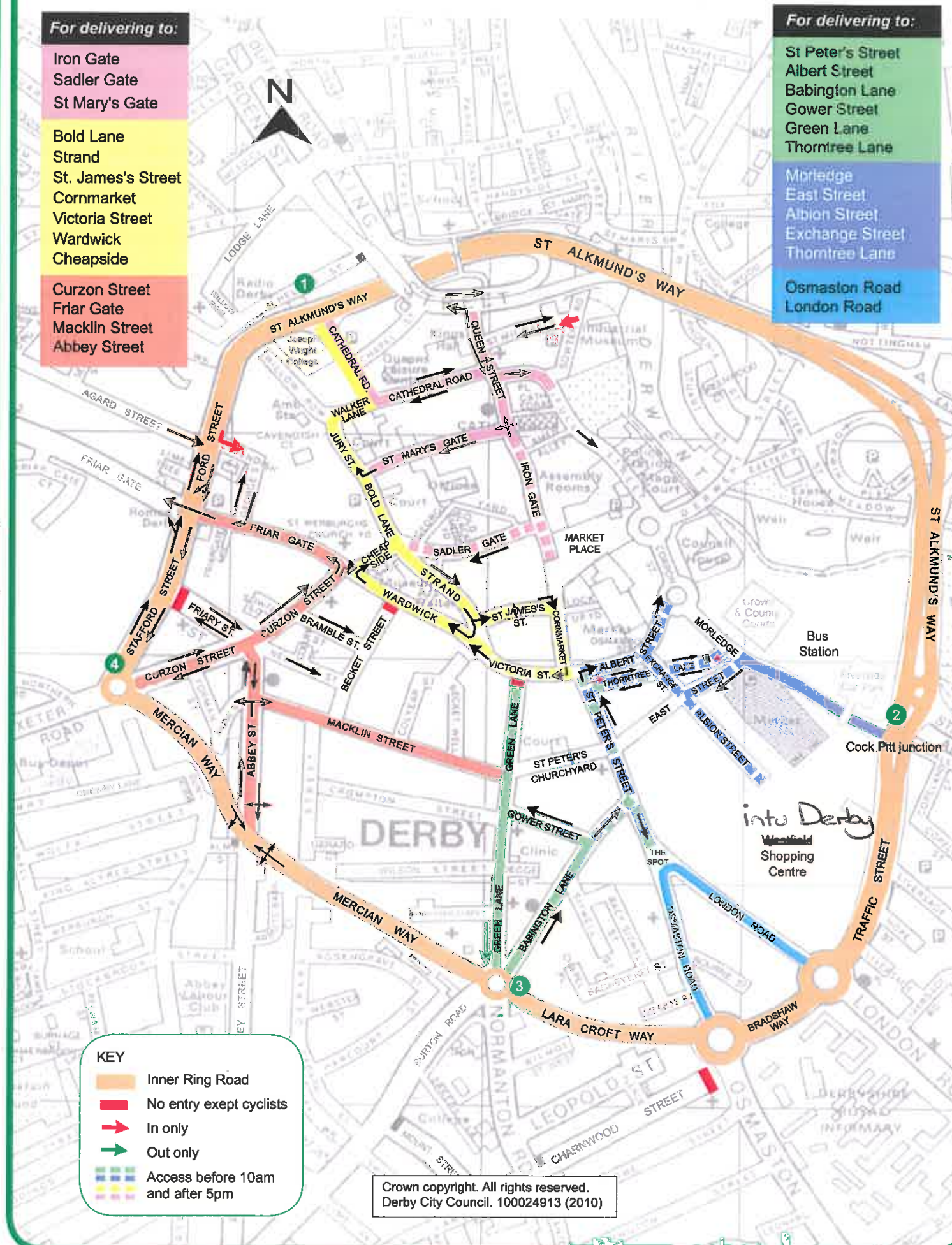

Delivery to Derby City Centre

Many of the streets in Derby City Centre are pedestrianised and others have traffic restrictions which severely restrict vehicle movements. This arrangement helps to ensure that the city centre remains an attractive, clean and safe environment for shoppers and visitors whilst allowing reasonable access for service deliveries and collections. These arrangements mean that the city centre can only be accessed from certain points.

The four main access points for vehicles entering the city centre are on the points of access plan are:

- 1 Cathedral Road opposite BBC Radio Derby
- 2 Morledge from the Cock Pitt junction
- 3 Babington Lane from the Lara Croft Way roundabout
- 4 Curzon Street from the Uttoxeter New Road roundabout

For deliveries to Victoria Street and Albert Street

Deliveries to these streets can only take place **before 10am and after 5pm**. Access to Albert Street **must** be from St Peter's Street and access to Victoria Street **must** be from the Cornmarket.

The only exemptions are:

- emergency services
- bullion vehicles making cash collections or deliveries to and from banks and building societies
- post office vehicles
- statutory services

For deliveries to:

- Iron Gate* (unless HGV)
 - Sadler Gate*
 - Bold Lane
 - Strand
 - St James's Street*
 - Cornmarket*
 - Victoria Street*
 - Wardwick
- * time restrictions apply

Use the Cathedral Road entry point off St Alkmunds Way on the Inner Ring Road to access Iron Gate which allows access to Sadler Gate. Access to Cornmarket, Victoria Street and Wardwick is via Bold Lane, Strand and St James's Street. No access to Sadler Gate, St James's Street (part of), Cornmarket and Victoria Street is allowed between 10am and 5pm, on all days.

For deliveries to:

- Morledge
 - East Street*
 - Albion Street*
 - Exchange Street*
 - Thorntree Lane*
- * time restrictions apply

Use the Cock Pitt junction with Morledge on the Inner Ring Road. Access to Albion Street and Exchange Street is via East Street. Access to Thorntree Lane is via Morledge or Exchange Street. Two-way traffic is allowed over a section of Thorntree Lane but exit onto Morledge is prohibited. No access to East Street, Albion Street, Exchange Street and Thorntree Lane is allowed between 10am and 5pm, on all days.

For deliveries to:

- Babington Lane
 - Green Lane
 - London Road
 - Osmaston Road
 - St Peter's Street*
 - Albert Street*
 - Thorntree Lane*
- * time restrictions apply

Use Osmaston Road for access to London Road as shown on the points of access plan. For access to all other roads listed above use Babington Lane but be aware that access beyond The Spot and St Peter's Street, Thorntree Lane and Albert Street is not allowed between 10am and 5pm, on all days.
