

# RESIDENT PARKING ZONE 26 - MOUNT STREET AREA

## Resident Parking Scheme

### HOURS OF OPERATION OF THE SCHEME

Monday to Sunday, 8am to 6pm, including bank holidays.

Outside of these hours, there will be no restrictions on parking, except where yellow lines apply.

These areas are for the use of residents who must hold a valid residents parking permit or their visitors who must be issued with a valid visitors permits.

You may issue visitor permits for those undertaking maintenance or improvements to your home. A permit does not guarantee you a parking space.

Any yellow lines or limited restrictions within the resident parking zone will continue to apply.

Generally, loading is permitted but not near junctions. Loading and unloading must be taking place and the vehicle must be moved as soon as the process is complete. Loading only includes the movement of heavy goods and bulky items to and from premises and the checking and signing of any associated paperwork.



### RESIDENT PERMITS

- Permits are available to certain residents in the zone
- The permit allows you to park in any of the bays or area within a zone. It is not street specific.
- There are specific conditions on the issue of business permits as they have to relate to vehicles required operationally for the business within the zone.

### RESIDENT VISITOR PERMITS

- Daily permits are available for your visitors.
- Visitor permits are only valid for your visitors.

### INFORMATION FOR YOUR VISITORS

Paper visitor permits:

- If you have a paper visitor permit, you must scratch off the day, date and month of use.
- You must clearly display the permit in your vehicle.

Digital visitor permits:

- The person you are visiting should activate a digital permit for your vehicle using MiPermit.

Permits are only valid whilst visiting the address associated with the permit. The permit is no longer valid once you are no longer visiting.

### CHARGES

The Council will cover the cost of permits for one year when a new scheme is introduced. After that the charges will be as follows:

- First residents permit - £25.00
- Additional residents permits - £50.00
- Visitor permits - £0.80 per sheet of four or £4.00 for a batch of 20 digital visitor permits.

### BLUE BADGE HOLDERS

Blue Badge holders can also park in resident parking zones, but must display their Blue Badge. Motorists who park in a resident parking zone without a residents' parking permit or Blue Badge will risk receiving a Penalty Charge Notice.

### HOW TO OBTAIN A PERMIT

All parking permits are now digital. This means that if you have a current paper permit, when it comes to renewing your permit, you will need to do this through the Mi Permit online store: [secure.mipermit.com/derby/application/home.aspx](https://secure.mipermit.com/derby/application/home.aspx)

If you are a new customer then you will need to create an account with Mi Permit and purchase your digital permit.

### IF YOU MOVE HOUSE

If you have moved address within six months of purchasing your permit, please contact MiPermit via the MiPermit online store and ask to have your address transferred. If you have moved address after six months of purchasing your permit, you will need to purchase a new permit.

### WHAT HAPPENS IF I CHANGE MY VEHICLE?

As all of our permits are digital, you will be able to change the vehicle registration on your digital permit by logging into your MiPermit account and going to 'Manage Digital Permits', the changes made will take effect immediately. If you fail to update the vehicle registration, the permit becomes invalid and you will risk receiving a Penalty Charge Notice.

### RENEWAL OF PERMITS

A reminder will be sent to your MiPermit email address a few weeks before your permit expires. You can renew your permit with MiPermit.

### PAPER PERMITS

Paper permits are still available for purchase if you do not wish to use digital permits.

- Your permit is only valid throughout Zone 26.
- Permit holders only restrictions apply Monday to Sunday, 8am to 6pm.
