Derby City Council (Kedleston Road & Allestree Lane Junction Area) (Moving Vehicle Restriction) (Amendment to Map Based Schedule) (No. 57) Order 2022

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Derby City Council proposes to make the above Orders under Sections 1, 2, 4, 9, 32, 35, 45, 46, 47, 49, 53 and part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and under the Traffic Management Act 2004 and all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of schedule 9 to the 1984 Act proposes to make the following Orders.

The purpose of these orders is to introduce the following restrictions at the locations stated below:

No Waiting (At Any Time):

- Kedleston Road Service Road from the access to the southern car park of The Markeaton Pub to the access onto Allestree Lane.
- The proposed signalised junction area of Kedleston Road and Allestree Lane.

And the purpose of these orders is to introduce the following restrictions at the locations stated below:

Prohibition of Driving of Motor Vehicles:

- Section approximately five metres in length at the apex of the corner of the Kedleston Road Service Road running adjacent to The Markeaton Pub.
