Our role

We provide information, support and guidance to parents, schools, early years settings and other professionals. This includes:

For Pre-School Children

- Home visits
- Support with play and development
- Advice on toys and equipment

In School

- Support and advice for children, teachers, teaching assistants and support workers on reading and writing materials, print format, seating position, classroom resources, teaching techniques and implications for the wider school environment.
- Functional Vision Assessment
- Resources
- Training
- Mobility and Habilitation support - provided in partnership with Guide Dogs
- Vision awareness training for staff and peers
- Contributing to Education, Health and Care plans.

Working with other professionals, including health colleagues at the eye clinic.

Information relating to the eye condition and its implications for access.

Support for transitions into and between pre-school settings and schools.

Supporting opportunities for local peer group contact.
