All gather in silence.

At 10.55, The Very Revd
Dr Peter Robinson, Dean of
Derby, says:

*Let us remember before God
and commend to his sure
keeping:
those who have died for their
country in war;
those whom we knew and
whose memory we treasure;
and all who have died in the
service of humankind.*

Remembering

The Exhortation is read by a
representative of the Royal
British Legion:

*They shall grow not old, as we
that are left grow old;
age shall not weary them, nor
the years condemn.*

*At the going down of the sun
and in the morning,
we will remember them.*

All: We will remember them.

The Last Post, two minutes
silence, Reveille – Standards dip.

The Kohima Epitaph is read by
a representative of the Royal
British Legion:

*When you go home tell them of
us and say: for your tomorrow,
we gave our today.*

The Dean of Derby says:
*Ever-living God
we remember those whom you
have gathered
from the storm of war into the
peace of your presence;
may that same peace calm
our fears,
bring justice to all peoples
and establish harmony among
the nations,
through Jesus Christ our Lord.*

All: Amen.
